Ebenezer DTC was officially established in 2009 after God gave the vision for a gospel-centered training program to raise up indigenous disciples in Haiti. Through a series of God ordained events and partnerships, land was donated and a pastor was trained to teach the first class of students.

Students from all over Haiti attend the school for 3 months and are taught the Discipleship Essentials curriculum by Haitian pastors. They study together and go on outreach trips to share the gospel to neighboring villages. After the training, the students go back to their villages and share what they have learned. Through these students, many have come to know and experience the love of Christ and have given their lives to the Lord.

Ebenezer Discipleship Training Center seeks to raise up and equip indigenous disciples of Jesus Christ in Haiti while helping to transform the community and surrounding areas in which it operates, through the local church, by joining what Christ has already started.

We also seek to encourage spiritual growth in the short term missionaries who visit and to help them understand that when they go home they are indigenous missionaries themselves.
